- 5. The Guardian ad Litem shall appear at all hearings or proceedings concerning custody and/or visitation scheduled in this cause, shall assure proper representation of the child(ren) at said hearings, and shall file a report with the Court.
- 6. The Guardian ad Litem shall be notified by the attorneys for the parties of any hearings, investigations, depositions or other proceedings concerning the child(ren) and shall receive notice prior to any action taken on behalf of the child(ren) by any party. The Guardian ad Litem is ordered to send copies of all pleadings or reports to all attorneys of record when said reports or pleadings are filed with the Court.
- 7. All parties and their attorneys are hereby ordered to cooperate with the Guardian ad Litem regarding interviews with the Guardian ad Litem.
